— CPC Inquiry Specification Table

Field	What to provide	Why it matters
Fixed carbon	Target value or range	Helps match carbon level and application
Sulfur content	Maximum value or target range	Important for aluminum carbon materials, metallurgy and foundry use
Ash, moisture, volatile matter	Test value or target range	Used to evaluate batch condition and impurity control
Particle size	Target particle size range	Affects screening, packing and application

— Inquiry Checklist

- Product name: CPC / Calcined Petroleum Coke
- Application and target specs
- Particle size, quantity and packing
- Destination and expected delivery time
